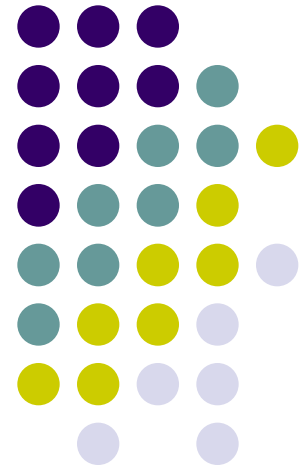
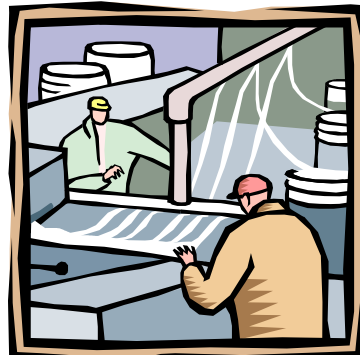


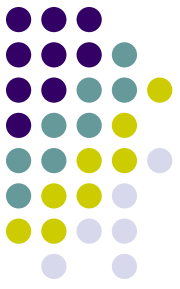


Arizona VPP Update

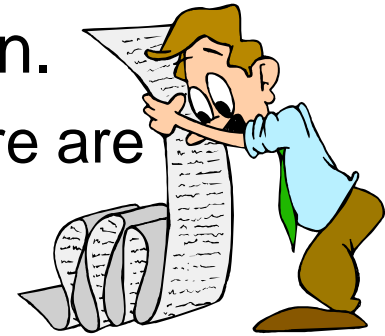

Progress in the year



- Arizona remains committed to VPP
 - Currently we have 24 Approved VPP sites.
 - Since the last VPPPA Regional Arizona lost 2 facilities, 1 due to a plant consolidation and the second to a closure.
 - One additional VPP site was a voluntary withdrawal
 - Activity since the last Regional Convention.
 - Arizona has done 6 re-certifications, and there are three pending for the remainder of 2009.
 - 2010 Shows that there are no less the 10 re-certifications due and we anticipate no less then 3 – 4 new applicant based on projections and input from employers. (most likely more)



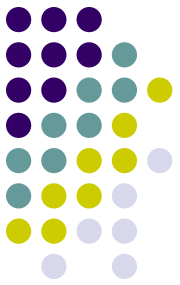
ADOSH Update continued.



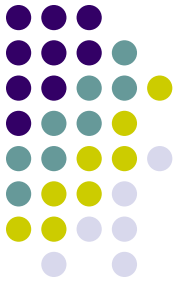
- Since last regional update these are the new sites who have submitted applications and been approved.
 - August 2008 – Mesquite Power
 - September 2008 – Hamilton Sundstrand
 - December 2008 – Fluor Facility & Plant Services

During the same time

During the same period of time two other sites submitted applications and they were denied following the review.



Projections



- ADOSH is making steady progress in the C-VPP program and two of the three companies in the pilot for construction have submitted applications, with one onsite already completed and the second onsite to be done in 2 weeks.
 - Granite Construction Application submitted, onsite done. 90 Day items being worked.
 - Hunt Construction – Application submitted and approved, onsite June
 - Hunter Construction – Application pending, anticipate submission very soon.

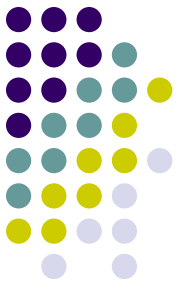
Developments



- ADOSH Anticipates opening this up to construction in very near future.
- ADOSH Conducted at least 4 informational sessions (1-2 hours average) on VPP for various organizations such as State Compensation Fund of Arizona.
- Presented Construction VPP overview to AGC March 2009
- Speaking to Risk Management associations as Keynote speaker on VPP July 2009
- Several other dates pending to discuss VPP
- ADOSH to be recognized by Arizona Chapter ASSE for community Safety service award – much of it due to VPP, SHARP, Partnerships and Consultation programs 5-22-2009.
